- Serious consequences for infractions up to and including disqualification and notification of university officials












Aero Design East 2025 flying site location










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








Aero Design East 2025 flying site location














Aero Design East 2025 flying site diagram











Flying site access

The following entry and exit rules below are government requirements set by the US Army Corps of Engineers, who manage the park the flying site is in.

- 1. The park cannot be entered before 6AM. Please do not ask to get in before 6AM.
- 2. Teams must use the Mustang Park gate for field access.
- 3. Speed limits in the park must be observed.
- 4. Teams that do not have their own vehicles must prearrange for their own reliable and scheduled transportation. This transportation must be at the field to pick teams up no later than 6PM Saturday and 3PM Sunday. You must have transportation with enough seats for all team members.
- 5. All SAE traffic must exit via the Mustang Park gate
- 6. All teams must be out of the park by 7 PM.
- Our last volunteer workers cannot leave the field until all teams have left.
- 8. Please be polite and cooperative at all times with all park officials and with the event officials and volunteers. See rules number 1.17.1 and 1.17.2.
- 9. Typical April weather can **easily exceed 80 degrees**, and lows can be in the 50s. Please plan accordingly. **Stay hydrated!** We have free bottled water on or near the paved parking lot.
- 10. Don't forget the sun block!









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Tents

- One table per team
- Four chairs per team
- No electricity in tents: use power/charging area for power needs.
- Electric aircraft can be ground tested outside the tents and well away from people No motor running in the tents.
- Please remember: only team members can work on aircraft. Please do not allow ineligible people to work on your aircraft.

- 8:30 AM 5:00 PM: Inspections. Teams are assigned tables and time slots. Please show up on time at the correct table




Please come prepared for Technical/Safety Inspection on Friday at your designated time.

- Teams **MUST** complete Self-Certification this year via <u>www.saesars.com</u>
 - Teams will receive team subscription code to perform this task 2 weeks prior to event.
- Teams MUST be registered and have wrist bands in order to be inspected
- Passing Technical Inspection is required to participate in Competition Flying on Saturday and Sunday
- If you are not prepared and/or miss your scheduled inspection time, you will be subject to delays which could impact your ability to compete (you may not get inspected until Saturday)



New Tech Inspection Flow


















Point value of Requirement:





- If team self-certified that they met the requirement and the judge confirms, no points will be assessed
- If team self-certified that they met the requirement and the judge cannot confirm, requirement's point value will be assessed
- If team elect to skip self-certification, requirement's point value will be automatically assessed and the team will need to bring the aircraft into compliance
- Teams CANNOT elect to skip self-certification on [Absolute Requirements]

Self-Certification

- [Absolute Requirement] A requirement that must be satisfied to participate in the flying portion of the event
 - Example: If the [absolute requirement] is to have a maximum wingspan of 10ft (120 inches), the team cannot skip this [absolute requirement] and elect to take the penalty points and use a 20ft wing instead.
- [Absolute requirements] will be clearly marked on the Self-Inspection screen 7-Advanced Class Wingspan

Getting Ready to Fly

- 1. Pickup Flight Log & Flight Ticket from HQ
 - 1. Flight Log: History of aircraft flight Cannot fly without log
 - 2. Flight Ticket: For Scoring Cannot earn points without ticket
- 2. Proceed to Pit Area and meet a pre-flight Flight Steward
 - 1. No repairs in the pit area.
 - 2. Team Must be ready to fly.
 - Flight ticket, Flight log, safety glasses, arming plug, radio(s), pilot(s) (if shared, must be in close proximity), necessary hardware and tools, Recovery Crew, Assembly & Launch Crew, spotter for photography



Post Flight Procedures

Successful flight:

- Meet a Post Flight Steward who will have your flight card and flight ticket to assist at the weigh station
- Be prepare for the unloading time event at the Weigh Station

For Unsuccessful Flight attempts

- Must wait for team's flight log to return to HQ (By Flight Steward) before another flight ticket can be issued
- If Re-Inspection is required, team must have Tech Inspection cleared by tech inspector before a ticket is issued
